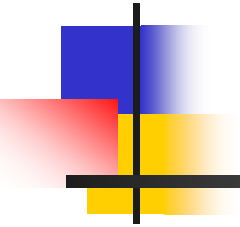

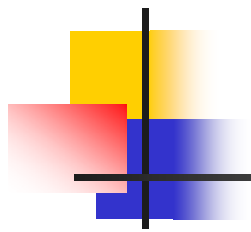

- Establishment of Fire Service in Pakistan
- Municipal Fire Brigades in Karachi, Lahore, Rawalpindi, and Peshawar
- Municipal Fire Brigade Act enacted 1949 replacing the 1911 Act
- High Power meeting – 1951
- Civil Defence Act – 1952.

- Policy

# PROVINCIAL LEVEL

---

- Preparation of Schemes and Policies on the lines suggested by the Federal Government
- Implementation of Fire Policy in the Provinces
- Arranging Training for Instructors and Fire Fighters.
- Coordination of the work of various departments and agencies
- Maintain liaison with municipal authorities for proper functioning of fire brigades



# DISTRICT/LOCAL LEVEL

---


- Maintenance of Fire Brigades in each town/city in line with the criteria set by the Federal and Provincial Governments
- Acquiring training for the fire personnel from the Federal Training institutions
- Proper manning and equipping the Fire Service
- To carry out fire fighting operations
- To send reports to authorities



# PRESENT STATE OF OPERATIONAL CAPABILITIES.

---

- Fire Service is not performing up to the mark presently
- Fire Brigades are inadequately manned and equipped
- Fire Fighting Vehicles possessed by the Fire Service are of old Vintage hence unable to produce desired results
- Requisite accessories to fight fires are not available

- Fire Crew is not properly trained
  - Physical standard of fire personnel is not up to the desired standards
  - Operational Capability of fire crew is not up to the mark



# IMPROVEMENTS IN OPERATIONAL CAPABILITIES

---

- Latest training be provided to the personnel of fire service
- The fire equipment require to be updated
- The obsolete equipment needs to be replaced
- Generous budgetary allocations need to be made at all levels
- Coordination between the Federal and Provincial levels need to be further strengthened.
